



THE PROJECT

The supply and construction of sanitary facilities in remote and backward villages. The majority of population are compelled to live in dry and barren land, with comparatively low rainfall and lack centralized water supply systems or sewerage facilities.

The intention of the National Council of Sri Lanka is to build toilets in each conference starting the second half of 2017 by employing direct labour obtained from the villages themselves under the supervision of a competent engineer or suitable person/s. Fellow Vincentians will also be involved and will oversee the project.

The cost per toilet is NZD\$600
